What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Conservative Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Wealth Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The Conservative Fund is invested up to 20% in shares and other growth assets, with the remainder invested in cash and fixed interest assets. Its objective is to exceed over the relevant timeframe the returns you would receive from investing 85% of your funds in New Zealand fixed interest and cash assets and 15% in global shares, through active asset allocation and active selection of shares, fixed interest and cash assets.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Conservative Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

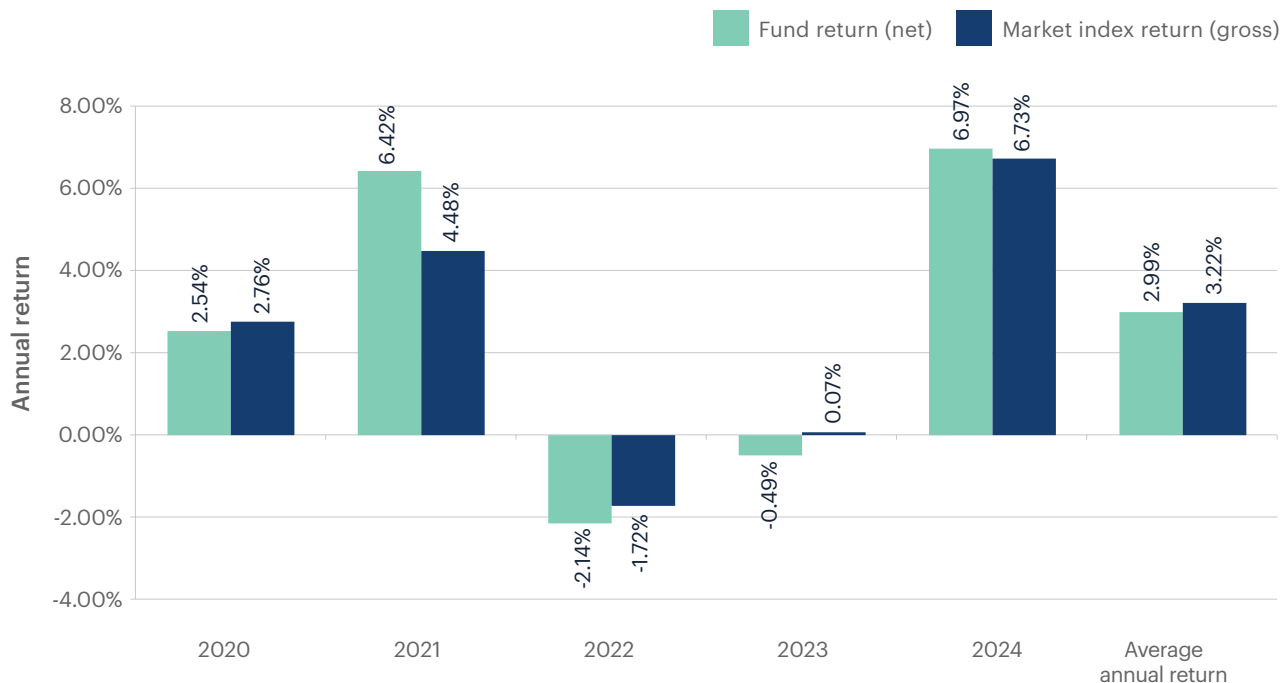

How has the fund performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 September 2024.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Conservative Fund are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2024 these were:

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term. GST is included in the Manager's basic fee and has been added to the Other management and administration charges (estimate) where applicable.



Example of how this applies to an investor

Alice had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Alice received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,008 (that is 10.08% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Alice a total return after tax of \$1,008 for the year.
