

# Fisher Funds KiwiSaver Scheme Investment Update

### What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Balanced Strategy has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the investment option with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

### Description of this investment option

This investment option aims to provide a balance between stability of returns and growing your investment over the long term by investing in a mix of income and growth assets. Automatically rebalanced each year to a target fund mix determined by us. As at the date of this fund update the target fund mix is 33.4% Conservative Fund and 66.6% Growth Fund.

### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Balanced Strategy:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the investment option's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

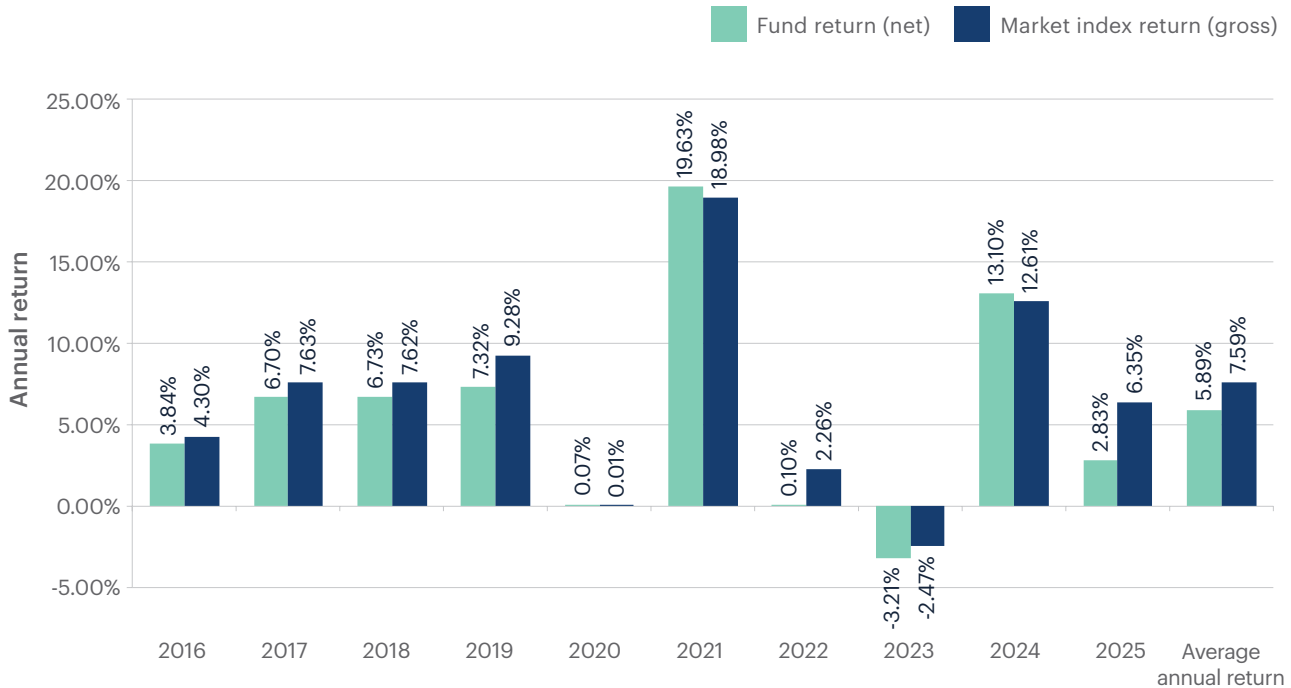

### How has the investment option performed?

## Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each of the last 10 years ending 31 March. The last bar shows the average annual return for the last 10 years, up to 31 December 2025.

Returns in this update are after tax at the highest prescribed investor rate (PIR) of tax for an individual New Zealand resident. Your tax may be lower. The market index return reflects no deduction for charges and tax.

## What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Balanced Strategy are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2025 these were:

\* In the year to 31 March 2026 we expect the total fund charges to be 1.06% as a result of an increase in Other management and administration charges. This is due to an increased exposure to private equity assets.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



### Example of how this applies to an investor

Sarah had \$10,000 in the investment option at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$393 (that is 3.93% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$393 for the year.

### Actual investment mix

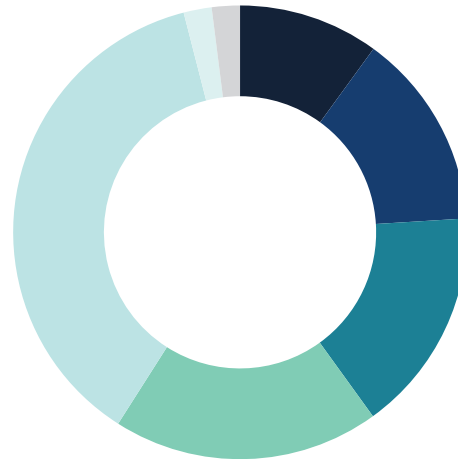
This shows the types of assets that the investment option invests in.
