What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the GlidePath Age 50 has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this Fund

GlidePath age 50 is a representation of the GlidePath life cycle. This investment option invests 86% in the Growth Fund and 14% in the Conservative Fund.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the GlidePath Age 50:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

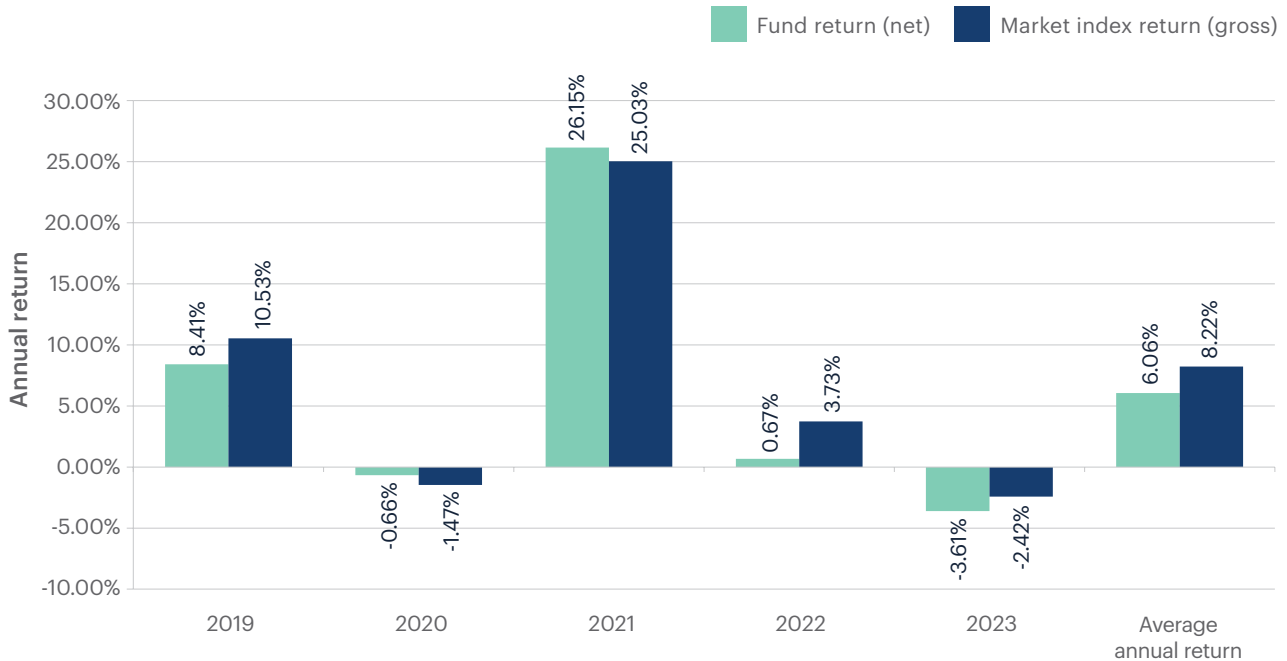

How has the fund performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 31 December 2023.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in GlidePath Age 50 are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2023 these were:

There is no extra charge for GlidePath. The annual fund charges for the underlying fund(s) apply.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



Example of how this applies to an investor

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,349 (that is 13.49% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$1,349 for the year.

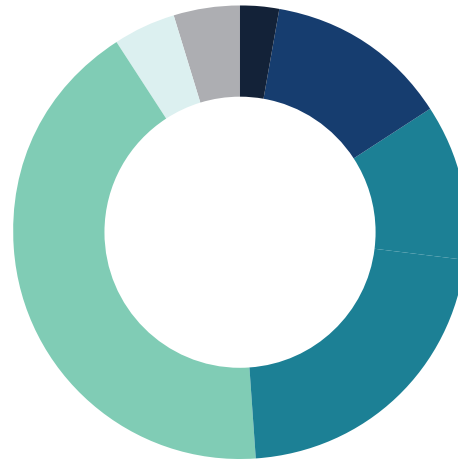
