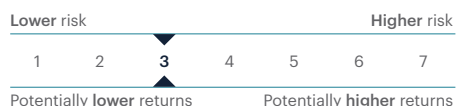
Description of this Fund

The fund aims to provide stable returns over the long term by investing in New Zealand and international fixed interest assets.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Premium Income Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

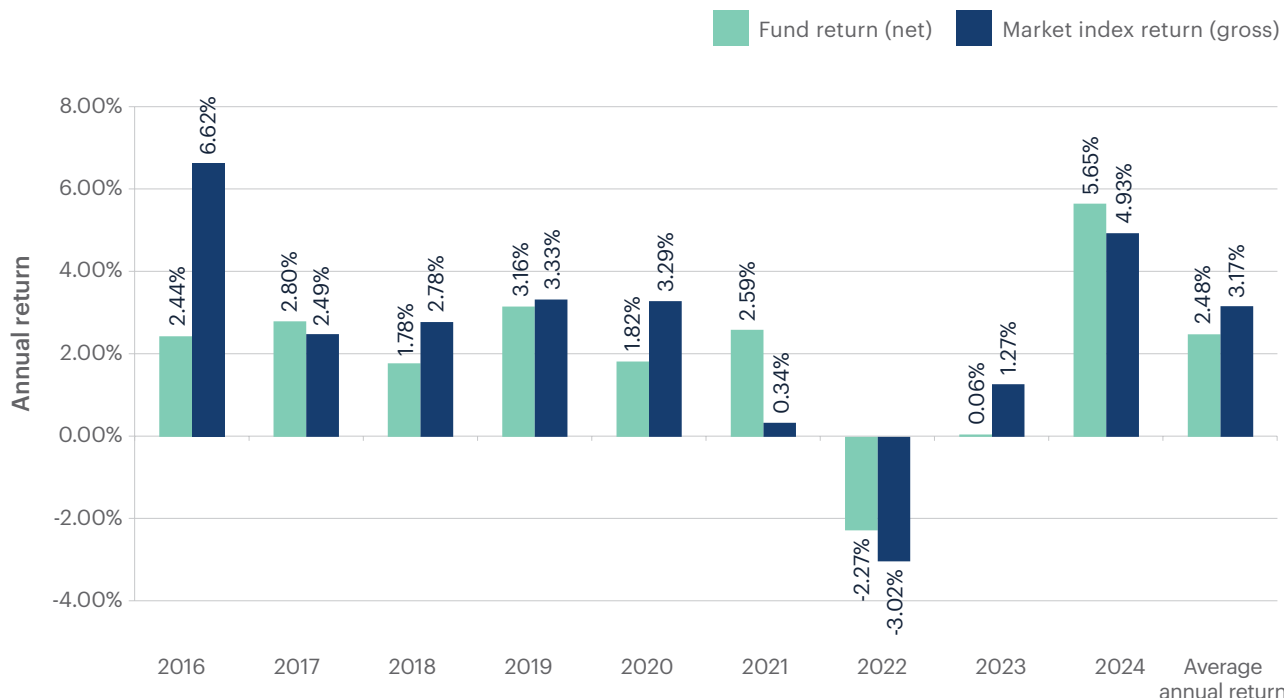

How has the fund performed?

Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 September 2024.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Premium Income Fund are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2024 these were:

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



Example of how this applies to an investor

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$770 (that is 7.70% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$770 for the year.

What does the fund invest in?

Currency hedging

The benchmark currency hedge ratio for International fixed interest is 100% hedged into NZD. At quarter end the fund was 100.0% hedged into NZD.
